SITE RULES

We are privileged to be able to race at this superb venue. Please follow these simple rules:

- 1. No dogs are allowed on site**
- 2. Do not bring dirt or gravel on to the track surface**
- 3. Only 'official' event vehicles are allowed on the race circuit.**
- 4. The gravel traps are specially prepared to absorb energy from crashing cars. Do not disturb or walk on the gravel, as it diminishes its effectiveness and requires re-setting at high cost.**





Venue

Mallory Park Circuit, Church Road, Kirkby Mallory, Leicestershire, LE9 7QE.

Follow ATW signage towards the Car Park and Race HQ.

Parking

Ample Parking is available – please follow the car park marshal instructions in the main carpark. Parking at the venue is charged at £3 per car. We strongly promote car sharing where possible. The parking fee will be collected on exit from the venue to avoid queues on arrival. Please provide cash where possible.

Changing and Toilets

There are toilets available at HQ in the toilet blocks. Also, in these blocks are a small changing facility, including showers – This is a small white building in the centre of the paddock.

Getting changed in the café is prohibited.

Photography

Refreshments

There is a café onsite, serving hot drinks, food and light snacks.

On-course refreshments

Teams will be provided with a gazebo to leave any baggage/personal refreshments. Another gazebo will be available for competitors to leave their own stuff if they wish and a final gazebo will be a water station provided by ATW – this will include water, energy gels, high 5 electrolyte drink and other snacks.





Registration

The centre of the track is accessed via the bridge from the car park.

Registration Opens: 6:30am.

This will be located in the 'signing on room' – Look out for the registration flag when you enter the centre of the track.

At registration you will be required to give the team name you used to sign up to the event online.

In exchange, you will be given an envelope containing two race numbers per teammate and safety pins.

One of the race numbers will have a timing chip (foam strip) on the back. This **MUST NOT** be removed and to be worn on the front. The other number to be worn on the back. Numbers must be worn visible on the front and back of each runner.

Age identifiers for those 35 years plus can be picked up at race number pick up.

Safety pins will be available at registration if required.

Spectators

Spectators are encouraged to attend our events to give that extra support to clubmates, friends and family taking part.

Spectators are allowed on the racing track to get close up to the athletes, but must not walk/stand in the gravel traps.

Marshals

Schedule of events:

6:30am – Registration Open

8am – 100k Start

9am – 50k Start

8pm – Cut off time

* Presentations will take place on the stage throughout the day as results become ratified.

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50k/100k - 3-mile lap



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50k/100k – Feed Stations



You will pass the feed station on every lap. Please use the correct gazebo, the order will be as follows: England, Ireland, Northern Ireland, Scotland, Wales, Open race area to put own food/drinks and finally a feed station supplied by ATW including tea/coffee for team coaches and officials. Please DO NOT litter on the course. Bins will be provided after the feed zone, before exiting the paddock and after.

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Anglo Celtic Plate Rules and Pen Portraits

Key Rules

- If raining, vest and bib numbers must be visible at all times.
- No support on the course other than in the feed zone. Athletes can only be given food and drink in the feed zone.
- Support Team members must stand and deliver behind the line marked on the course in the feed zone, they are not allowed to run after the athlete to help them if they drop their drinks.
- As it is the British, Irish and Scottish Championships pacing is not allowed. For the avoidance of doubt men can run with men and women can run with women. However, men and women cannot run together as this will be regarded as pacing.
- Under Championships rules no headphones are allowed.
- NO littering on the course. Bins will be provided.

Race Brief

A race brief will be taking place 10 minutes before the start of the 50k & 100k at the start line. To get to the start, you will either be walked over from the paddock by an ATW staff member or feel free to make your way around to the start if you know the location of this. Please see the map on page 6 to see the locations of the starts.

Course

The run course follows a 3-mile lap around Mallory Park Race Circuit. Starting and finishing in the centre of the track. Here you will head out onto the track turning left, following the race circuit around the big lake until reaching the turnaround point and heading back the way you came. You will then climb to the highest point, up the hill and around the hairpin, following the track around the devil's elbow and down the home straight, under the bridge before reaching the next turnaround point. Returning back the way you came, head up and down the hill, before turning left into the pit lane, and doubling back into the paddock area to head to the finish line.

Anglo Celtic Plate Awards

- OPEN RACE AWARDS: to be confirmed based on entry numbers
- UK ATHLETICS (UKA) AWARDS: British championship medals will be awarded to the first 3 British qualified men and first 3 British Qualified women in both the 100km and the 50km
- ANGLO CELTIC PLATE: The Men's and Women's Anglo Celtic Plate will be awarded to the first Home Nations team both male and female. Scoring is on cumulative time of each nations first three finishers,
- BRITISH MASTERS ATHLETIC FEDERATION (BMAF) AWARDS: BMAF medals will be awarded in 5-year age bands in accordance with WMA rules.
- NORMAN WILSON TROPHY: Will be awarded to the fastest 100km debutants male and female.
- THE DON RITCHIE AWARDS.





Results

Results are calculated by ATW's timing partner, [EventChipTiming](#). Your time will be uploaded to their website once an internet connection has been established

Due to the chip-timed nature of the event, final race results may differ from finishing positions.

The chip data requires WIFI access and occasionally we have to load this data in manually after the event if the connection is lost. If you have a query on your chip time, please wait until the evening of the event before raising the query.

Please note that if you are using GPS to measure your run distance, GPS devices are NOT accurate and consistent enough to measure a course for certification. The course has been officially measured and holds a certificate of course accuracy. Please read the guidance below.

In addition, the time you record on your smart phone is not a reliable guide and will not be your correct chip timed result. Please wait until the official results are published to find out your accurate finish time.

Following the event, the results will be published on the RunBritain website. Following this, the "Power of 10" rankings will be updated by RunBritain, this normally takes around 7 days.
