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BRITISH MASTERS ATHLETIC FEDERATION Financial statements for the year ended 31st May 2023 Honorary Treasurer's Report on these Financial Statements

I stated last year "This is my sixth and final report as Hon Treasurer before standing down at this year's AGM. I intended to stand down after completion of a five year term but, as no successor came forward, I have acted for a further 12 months".

At the time of writing this, a successor has still not come forward this year either. However there remain advanced plans for incorporation of the Federation (to operate alongside the already incorporated BMAF Services Limited). In the meantime, having been appointed Vice-Chairman of the Federation, I am also acting as Treasurer and so here is my seventh report!

Nearly all the Treasury functions have now been successfully transferred to the very efficient team at BMAF Services Limited "Services"). The Federation continues to receive Affiliation fees from the eleven Area Clubs although the invoicing is now done by Services. I collected one donation from an anonymous donor. I paid grants to Services and some expenses detailed in these accounts.

It is proposed not to increase the Affiliation fees for 2024/25 but to hold them at the 2023/24 level of £4 per member, despite significant inflationary and other pressures referred to below.

As will be seen from the 2022/23 accounts, both BMAF and BMAF Services Limited reported a slight loss. We anticipate no decrease in overall costs next year and indeed it now appears essential to outsource some services, which will obviously push up our costs. This is due to the lack of volunteers and expertise as well as being due to too much work having to be handled by some existing volunteers. Whilst the committee is concerned that Affiliation fees, based upon £4 per member, may not be an adequate level in the future to cover all our annual costs, we currently have very satisfactory levels of reserves, reflected by high cash balances, and we can therefore afford not to request any increase in fees for 2024/25.

I draw your attention to the Funds in the Balance Sheet. The General fund is obvious and needs no comment.

The Maurice Doogan Bid Fund was explained last year and there are currently no proposals to make a Bid for an international competition and so this is carried forward. The Overseas Fund stands at £26,072. This represents cumulative surpluses made over many years out of the 10 Euro admin fees received from athletes' entry to overseas championships. This surplus arose because traditionally, the team managers claimed no travel or accommodation expenses. This situation has changed as Services, which has taken over the overseas finances, has agreed to pay an appropriate level of expense to non-competing team managers. therefore some of the accumulated surplus may be needed in future years.

The Income and Expenditure Account shows a general deficit of £2,790 although this is after a non-cash credit of £3,000, being a long-standing accounting provision for championship expenses which never materialised. So the real deficit for the year was £5,790. This arose because of the reduced Affiliation Fees, explained above, and higher IT costs within Services which necessitated grants of over £13,000 during the year.
